Clerk, Lower Division Clerk, Staff Car Driver and Dispatch Rider, and the Central Vigilance Commission (Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1988 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'C' posts in the Central Vigilance Commission, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement –

- (1) These rules may be called the Central Vigilance Commission, Group 'C' Posts, Recruitment Rules, 2019.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- **2. Application.** These rules shall apply to the posts specified in the column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- **3. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix. -** The number of posts, their classification and the level in pay matrix attached there to shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
- **4. Method of recruitment, age limit, and other qualifications, etc. –** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualifications - No person -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said post. Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- **6. Power to relax** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- **7. Saving -** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, ex-Service personnel and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
